KS3 assessments

Mr Aled Myrddin has sent out a letter to parents of key stage 3 pupils regarding CATS assessments and national reading and numeracy tests. This year the results of these are not being reported or used externally. These will be used by teachers to identify where each pupil is at present in order to adapt and target their teaching over the coming months. Pupils should not worry about the need for preparation and these results will not be used to judge individuals.

Years 11, 12 and 13 Assessments

Assessments for these years are continuing over the coming weeks. We understand that this is a new process for the pupils and that some feel stressed. We will continue to remind them that the assessments are based on the work they have done and not on aspects that have not been studied. If you have concerns about your children, please contact the progress and welfare leader.

Prosiect pleidlais

The Children's Commissioner for Wales is running a 'ballot project' with a parallel election for 11 to 15 year old school pupils across Wales.
