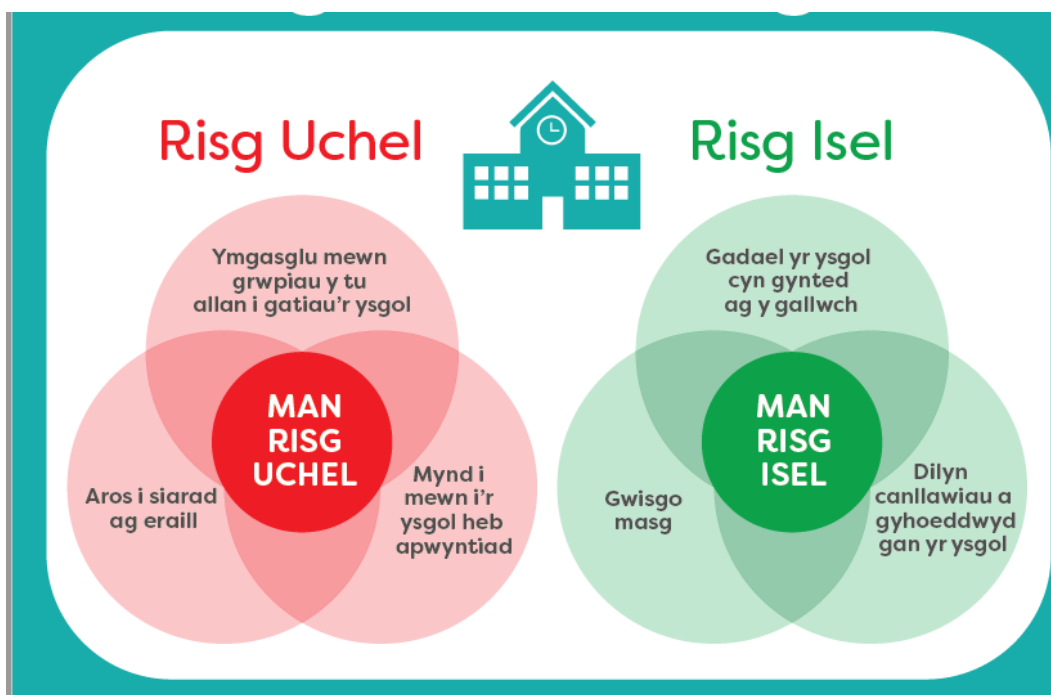
Gyrfa Cymru

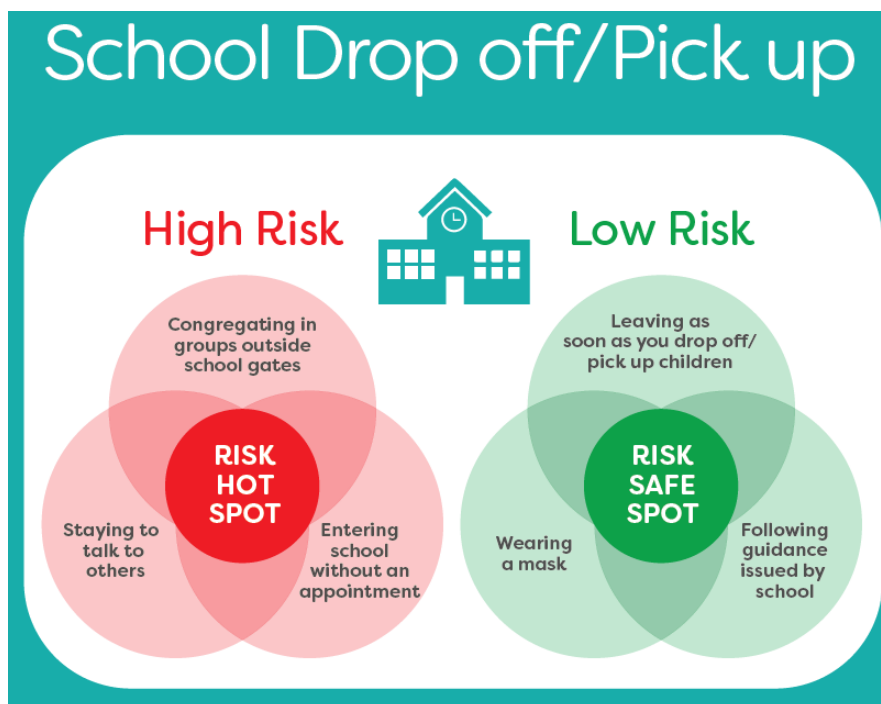
Careers Wales

Stay safe / Stay healthy
