Sharing KS4 and KS5 grades

This year's grading system allows us to share provisional grades with pupils before they are shared with the exam board. We can now confirm the dates for these:

- Provisional **A and AS level** provisional results will be shared on **Tuesday, 15th June**.
- Provisional **GCSE** results will be shared on **Wednesday, 16th June**.

Pupils who wish to discuss their grades will then be able to make an appointment to see a member of the extended leadership team. The government has not yet announced details of the appeal process but there will be an opportunity for pupils to ask the school to review the grade if they think there is a problem with the grading process.
