Cyfygiadau cenedlaethol

Mae hyn yn berthnasol mewn manau fel tafarndai a bwytai yn ogystal ag yng nghartrefi pobl.”



It's an uncertain time for all of us at the moment. Decisions taking place in Scotland, Northern Ireland and England have led many parents to ask us about the next steps for us in Wales in terms of exams and the possibility of extending half term. At the moment we have no more information than you about this. We are waiting to hear more about the summer 2021 exam arrangements next week and have planned on the basis of the usual half term. Senior prefects

Congratulations to Ioan Morris, Rhianedd Owen and Rhys Tanat for being selected as senior prefects. Congratulations also to their deputies, Elin Rattray, Ifan Davies and Mari Hefin. It was good to see pupils with a clear vision and ideas on how to make it happen during this unusual time. Thanks also to the other applicants - the competition was close and we were impressed by their ideas and contribution.

Congratulations to pupils

The school's enterprise and business work has already led to considerable success in national competitions. It was good to hear this week about more success with the 'Eli-Gant' team winning the award for the best business plan in Wales in the young enterprise competition.

Year 7 Pastoral Evening

Providing face-to-face information to you as parents is challenging under the current circumstances. To try to solve the problem we have ordered a resource to try and ensure that we can organize virtual parents' evenings that work for everyone. It is our intention to hold a pastoral evening for year 7 in the week beginning 9th November for year 7 parents to speak to the form tutor and / or progress and welfare leader for general feedback on wellbeing and progress their children during half term. If this is successful we will announce a formal parents' evening program for the other school years.

Masks

The Welsh Government and Ceredigion Council provide suitable masks for secondary pupils. These have arrived and we have started the process of distributing them to pupils. There are two for each pupil and this will help them as they travel on school buses and move around the school.

Accelerated Learning Programme

The government has introduced a grant to support pupils as they resume their education and prepare for external examinations. The focus of the grant is year 11-13 pupils, year 7 pupils and vulnerable pupils. This will enable us to provide a little more support for some pupils in the core subjects and to split some teaching groups into smaller ones. If this affects your son / daughter we will inform you.

Hafan

The Hafan provides support for vulnerable individuals. During the current period the Hafan can deal with fewer pupils than usual so pupils can arrange a session in the Hafan by **texting 07970069723 with their full name (pupil name) and school year.**

Seren Academy

The Seren academy is part of the national Seren network which aims to prepare pupils for applying to competitive universities. Pupils are identified based on their GCSE performance. Like everything this year, this was a virtual event, but after a few initial technological problems it was nice to see so many year 12 pupils involved in this year's academy launch. We hope this will inspire them to aim high for their future.

Welfare Survey

Pupils have received details of a county welfare survey through ShowMyHomework. This is part of the county's work as they seek to identify the impact of interventions and identify where to target additional support. If your child has not completed the survey we ask if they can do so during the week. I note the links below.

National Guidelines

Information has emerged that pupils from secondary schools in Aberystwyth and the surrounding area are attending parties where the rules and guidelines regarding Covid 19 cannot be observed, and which obviously pose a risk to safety. We have reminded pupils of the rules in place across Wales:

“Only the people who live with you (your household), and (if local restrictions do not prohibit it) members of your extended household if you have formed one, you can meet socially indoors . From 14 September, indoor gatherings and meetings, even within your extended household, must be limited to 6 people only (this does not include any children under 11).

This applies in places like pubs and restaurants as well as in people's homes.”

Work while absent

I would like to reiterate one message from the last bulletin as it is important. The school uses ShowMyHomework for feedback, but also to record homework. Where pupils are away from school for a period, staff will post any resources used in lessons on the website. If a pupil is instructed to self-isolate for a period through the NHS or County tracking system, the progress leader and place may arrange for subject work to be made available to them through ShowMyHomework. A message from Ceredigion County Council

 *Calling all parents/guardians.*

Remember you should not send your child to school if any member of your household has coronavirus symptoms, as all members of the household need to self-isolate.

Read on to find out for how long you need to self-isolate, and how to book a test. 

Together, we can keep Ceredigion safe.

Children and self-isolation

If any member of your child's household has coronavirus symptoms, the whole household will need to self-isolate, and you must not send your child to school.



- **How long to self-isolate?**

The individual who has the symptoms will need to self-isolate for 10 days from when the symptoms started, or until confirmation of a negative test.

All household members will need to self-isolate for 14 days from when the individual's symptoms started, or until confirmation of a negative test.

If a member of your household has been contacted by the Contact Tracing team, they will need to self-isolate for 14 days, even if they have a negative test result.
